Increase supply budget by \$2,000 from 1,000 to 3,000 to purchase a button maker for the students and promotional materials.

Brenda asked if we can look at other resources for our website.

Brenda, Ramon and Javier will get together to figure out a way to add gang prevention under goal 2.

Youth Prevention Activities: We took 7 students to a retreat at ESD 105 to Prepare for Policy Day in Olympia on Jan 20th where they will be talking to our legislators.

Sunnyside Police Department: They are working on crime watch and reducing crime. Also they are creating a fund which will be finalized between 6 months to a year. They are putting together a 1 cop one Congregation to build partnership and trust. In 2019 we were homicide free.

Granger Opioid Consortium: KDNA and CC Seamar got a Grant of \$300,000 that extends until 2021 to work on the opioid epidemic in the lower valley. They have a radio talk show on 91.9 which takes place on the first monday and third Friday of every month from 4pm-5pm. They asked if anyone knows of someone who can give their own testimony on the radio (it can be anonymous) to please reach out to them. Their consortium meeting is today(01/16/2020) at 2pm at KDNA.

Sunnyside & Granger School Safety Grant: There will be 30 minute talk shows at 11am. Ramon will be on air on Jan 26, Javier on Feb 11 and Nellie on Feb 25. If you know of anyone that should be on these talk shows please let us know.
